## **CHECKLISTS AND POLICIES**

### **SUMMARY CHECKLIST FOR THE CERTIFIED MUNICIPAL CLERK (CMC):**

First, enroll in the Oklahoma Municipal Clerks Institute (OMCI) by turning in your application and one-time fee of \$20 to OSU Center for Executive and Professional Development. Next, become a member of the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) by completing an Application for Admission and submit it to IIMC with the fee. You must be an IIMC member for two years to receive your CMC. Then, attend the Institute sessions and complete the assessment for each session. It should take approximately 3½ years to complete the education requirements for the CMC. Once you have completed your education and experience requirements, complete an Application for CMC Designation and submit it to IIMC with your supporting documents and the fee. Once you receive notification from IIMC of your CMC accomplishment, you are eligible to enroll into the Oklahoma Municipal Clerks Academy to achieve your Master Municipal Clerk Certification (MMC).

### **SUMMARY CHECKLIST FOR THE CERTIFIED PUBLIC FINANCE ADMINISTRATOR (CPFA):**

First, enroll in the Oklahoma Municipal Treasurers Institute (OMTI) by turning in your application and one-time fee of \$20 to OSU Center for Executive and Professional Development. Next, become a member of the Association of Public Treasurers of the United States and Canada (APT US&C) by completing an Application for Admission and submit it to APT US&C with the fee. You must be an APT US&C member for two years to receive your CPFA. Then, attend the Institute sessions and complete the assessment for each session. It should take approximately 3½ years to complete the education requirements for the CPFA. Once you have completed your education and experience requirements, complete an Application for CPFA Designation and submit it to APT US&C with your supporting documents and the fee. Once you receive notification from APT US&C of your CPFA accomplishment, you are eligible to enroll into the Oklahoma Municipal Clerks and Treasurers Academy to achieve your Advanced Certified Public Finance Administrator (ACPFA).

### **ATTENDANCE POLICY ENDORSED BY EDUCATION COMMITTEE**

Full attendance is required to receive credit for Institute sessions. In order to receive credit for each session, participants will be required to sign-in to the virtual sessions with their first and last name. Participants that registered and paid for a virtual session and were unable to attend the live session can receive a recording to watch. An assessment will be required after each session. Participants will be given 3 chances to earn a 70% or higher on the assessment to receive credit for the class.

#### **Cancellation Policy for the Institute**

Cancellations must be received 5 days before the first session of each quarter is set to start. If registering for individual sessions, cancellations must be received 5 days prior to the start of each session.
