IIMC has approved the sessions for the Region VIII Conference in Park City, Utah - September 22-24, 2021 as follows:

Members of the Park City Historical Society will greet us and guide three different walking tours: 1) Park City Museum, 2) Historic Main Street, and 3) Historic Glenwood Cemetery.

These walking tours will cover the architecture, people, and notable events of Park City’s history, from the mining boom to world class ski destination. Attendees will gain a better understanding of the importance of preserving records that have permanent historical value.

So put on some comfortable shoes and join us as we discover the history of this beautiful city. After the walking tours feel free to shop or enjoy dinner at one of the many fine restaurants on and around Main Street.
