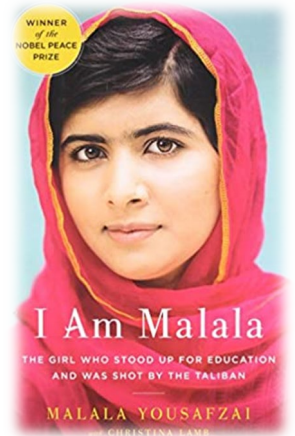
# ATHENIAN DIALOGUE

**What is an Athenian Dialogue?** Athenian Dialogues explore leadership principles and practice, drawing on the insights contained in a book that all participants have read. Dialogues are conversations in which clerks share their experience and understanding as it relates to the ideas of the author and the relevance of those ideas to their public leadership. Participants must maintain a video and audio connection for the entire duration of the dialogue.

**About our book:** A memoir by the youngest recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize, **I Am Malala** is the remarkable tale of a family uprooted by global terrorism, of the fight for girls' education, of a father who, himself a school owner, championed and encouraged his daughter to write and attend school, and of brave parents who have a fierce love for their daughter in a society that prizes sons. **I Am Malala** will make you believe in the power of one person's voice to inspire change in the world.
