

Letting people grow by believing in themselves is what Eelco drives daily; where people grow, organizations flourish. Educated as civil engineer and holding a master in Public Administration it is not difficult for him to build bridges between people. He has almost 30 years of experience in all levels of the government world. The last 15 years as a City Clerk. He is one of the three teachers in the training programs for Clerks and Deputy Clerks in The Netherlands. In his courses he likes to highlight and discuss the grey areas of working in an political environment. Parts that he also covered in trainings for civil servants on how to advise within the government. Eelco's certification in RealDrives and Profile Dynamics helps him to reflect on people's behavior and make it a topic of discussion. Because knowing and understanding your own drives is important for your personal development - Understanding others' drives provides tools for improving teams and the organization - Drives determine what and why people do what they do. Eelco received his Master Municipal Clerks designation in 2015; and was accepted as first Athenian Dialogue Facilitator outside the American continent in 2022.

Session Description:

"Dare to Lead" by Brené Brown is a leadership book that emphasizes the importance of vulnerability, courage, and empathy in effective leadership. It outlines four key skill sets for daring leaders: braving vulnerability, living into one's values, trusting, and rising. Brown argues that true leadership isn't about titles or power, but about recognizing potential and having the courage to develop it, even in the face of uncertainty and challenges.

In essence, "Dare to Lead" encourages leaders to cultivate a more human-centered approach, focusing on empathy, connection, and courage to foster a culture of trust, innovation, and resilience within their teams.
